### About us:

VoV was founded in November 1997 by Bay Area choral enthusiasts and made its debut performance at the San Francisco Asian Art Museum soon after. Many members trace their heritage from Hong Kong, Taiwan and China, and all share a passion in singing and performing for the community.

Ms Stephanie Chan, our founding music director, is a celebrated choral conductor and educator who studied music at San Francisco State University and graduated Summa Cum Laude. During her time serving as Music Director for St Paul's Co-educational College, they held the title of Best Choir at the Hong Kong Music Festival for 10 consecutive years. Ms Chan was also the Head of General Musicianship at the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts.

### Impact:

VoV performs publicly twice a year in the Bay Area, and our repertoire includes choral classics from different cultures and languages. We are proud to have premiered many works from Hong Kong composers in the US – including 李偉安 Warren Lee, 黎尚冰 Lai Sheung Bing, and 陳永華 Chan Wing Wah. We specialize in contemporary interpretation of Chinese classics by Chinese composers around the world – and also give highly technical and memorable performances of Western classics.

VoV performed Faure's Requiem with the Stanford University Orchestra under conductor 蔡金冬 Cai Jin Dong in 2008, and collaborated with the renowned Xia Men Philharmonic Orchestra at the San Francisco Davies Symphony Hall in 2009.

In 2010 and in 2013, VoV toured in Hong Kong and Taiwan, performing at the Chinese University of Hong Kong, the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, the Hong Kong Polytechnic and the Paper Dome Church in Taiwan.

In 2017, VoV joined the Hong Kong Oratorio Society in a concert tour sponsored by the Hong Kong Economic and Trade Office celebrating the 20th anniversary of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, and premiered the 8<sup>th</sup> Symphony 蒼茫大地 The Boundless Land by Dr Chan Wing Wah at the Herbst Theatre in San Francisco and the Disney Hall in Los Angeles.

VoV gives free performances at senior communities, churches and local trade expos. In 2024, we are invited to perform at the opening ceremony of the Asian Culture and Food Expo in San Mateo as a community sponsor.
